





#### **HORSE SCHEDULE RULES**

# RULES & REGULATIONS.competitrors are requested to read these regulations carefully.

ENTRY FEES: 1. Entry to all horse events will be by ticket only. You will purchase tickets to the value of the entry fee from Show Office and hand completed to Steward in the ring you are entering.

2. Entry Fees may be refunded only in special circumstances, and you must see Treasurer to get refund.

#### PAYMENT OF PRIZE MONEY:

- 3. Supremes/Champions/Championship classes will receive their money at the Show Office
- 4. Please ensure you have your Prize Money Voucher to collect Prize Money for Supremes/Championship.
- 5. All other prize money will be paid from Ring Office daily.
- 6. Prize money not collected by Sat 31st May 2025 will be forfeited and returned to the Society's funds.
- 7. All prize money and entry fees include GST which is payable by all competitors whether registered or not for GST purposes.

DISPUTES: 8. If a dispute arises as to the age of a competitor, the only proof of age accepted will be a

birth certificate.

9. No dispute to be considered whilst the event is in progress. Protests are to be lodged in writing after the event has been completed and must be handed to the Show Office, accompanied by a fee of \$50 within 30 minutes of completion of the event. Dispute Committee decision will be final.

GENERAL: 10. The show is conducted under the rules and regulations of Bundaberg A.P. & I. Society Inc. And Qld Agricultural Societies.

11. Measuring Steward is available if required.

- 12. All STALLIONS/COLTS, two years & over must be led in a bit. The handler/rider must have attained the age of 18 years on the day of the show.
- 13. All entries must be registered with the applicable Breed or Registered Societies or recorded in accordance with the rules of the respective breed society. Registration papers are required. NO REGISTRATION, NO ENTRY.
- 14. Competitors must wear CORRECT ATTIRE. Approved riding helmets AS/NZ/3838 2006 onwards. ARB HS 2012 provided they are SAI Global marked and riding boots essential. Jeans and T Shirts are not considered suitable attire.
- 15. No ring shall be required to wait for any competitor who may be competing in another ring.
- 16. An Exhibitor shall ensure that the horse and competitor are entered and shown only in correct class.
- 17. If in the opinion of the Judge, any horse or pony is entered in the wrong class, the Judge shall have the power to classify it in the correct class.
- 18. The age of a horse shall be calculated from 1st August in the year it is foaled.'
- 19. Stewards reserve the right to alter any event in the schedule.
- 20. Stewards reserve the right to refuse any entry without reason.
- 21. A Judge/Steward may direct any person or horse from the competition for bad conduct or one or both.
- 22. The Committee reserves the right to swab any horse, and swabbing may be done during Championship Events. Offenders will be banned.
- 23. An exhibit is ineligible to compete if the competitor/exhibitor is a member of the judge's family, if the horse has been owned or leased by the Judge or a member of his/her family within the last 3 months, if the competitor has received tuition from the judge within the last 3 months.
- 24. A Judge shall not visit the horse stables, nor the owners, nor inspect or discuss any horse that entered in the show prior to or during the judging of the relevant section.
- 25. HORSE HEALTH DECLARATIONS for bio security reasons must be completed and handed in at the Show Office upon arrival at the Precinct. Forms are available at Show Office or Show Society website. www.bundabergshow.com.au
- 26. All electrical equipment and leads must be tested and tagged to comply with safety regulations.
- 27. NO OPEN FIRES. TOTAL FIRE BAN ON SHOWGROUND
- LEDS: 28. All led classes will be completed before Ridden classes judged.
  - 29. All first-place winners in Gelding classes are eligible for Supreme Gelding of Show.
  - 30. Supreme led shall be judged after all Led classes are completed.
- HACKS: 31. Competitors are advised that riders in Hack, Galloway and Pony classes can only ride one horse in each event. Except where competitors have more than one entry for the Championship.
  - 32. District events are restricted to owners/riders residing within the BRC for a period of 6 months. With respect to Lease, the lessee shall be deemed to be owner if the lessee has been in possession of lease for 6 months prior to first day of show.
  - 33.A Novice is a horse or pony that has never won a Championship in a similar contest at an Agricultural Show.
  - 34. Pony n/e 14hh, Galloway over 14hh n/e 15hh, Horse over 15hh.

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35. Horses may be entered in Hack Classes or Hunter Hack Classes, but not in both. Open not compete in Show Hunter Classes.

Hacks may

- 36 Stallions are not permitted in Hack/Show Hunter Classes.
- 37. Stallions are ineligible.
- 38. Show Hunters have more substance than the modern fine Hack/Pony but still maintain quality.
- 39. They are expected to move freely.
- 40. They may at any time be expected to gallop for the Judge.
- 41. The Turnout for Show Hunters is more subdued than that of the usual saddle classes.
- 42. There should be no coloured browbands on Show Hunters, or Multi coloured hair ribbons or flowers on the child rider.
- 43. Junior Riders should not wear top boots. Tweed coats are optional.
- 44. Show Hunters cannot compete in any Novice or Open Hack Classes.
- 45. All show jumping events unless otherwise stated will be conducted under EFA rules.
- 46. A Junior Rider may compete in both junior and open competition provided they are members of EFA.
  - a. Junior EFA rules
  - b. Young Riders QLD EFA rules
- 47. All riders/competitors must compete in the correct dress, i.e., shirt, tie, jodhpurs, coat, approved riding helmet and boots. T Shirts and open neck shirts are not permitted.
- 48. Should entries be excessive; the jumping steward reserves the right to limit competitors to a set number of horses in each event. The number of horses will be determined by the final number of entries.
- 49. A draw will be conducted before each event and the draw will be displayed at the Judges Box. Horses must practically jump in order of draw.
- 50. All show jumping classes will be by EFA rules, unless otherwise stated. E.g., District, Children's Show Jump class

DOGS: Dogs come on Showgrounds/Precinct as the OWNERS RESPONSIBILITIES and must be securely chained inside vehicles or if under on a short lead so that they cannot dove out and bite anyone. Please clean up after your dog daily. **CAMPING & STABLES:** 



#### **RULES:**

- 1. All nominations will be by Ticket bought from Bundaberg show Secretary Office. Event Entry Ticket will be filled out with the name of rider and Horse's name. Tickets will be handed to the event steward prior to start of each relevant event.
- 2. Stewards/Judges will score each obstacle and time each rider in case there is a tie.
- 3. All riders need to be present at 8am for a walk through of the obstacles.
- 4. The Division times will be approximate, depending on nominations for each division.
- 5. Competitors/Horses names (tickets)will be provided to Stewards prior to the start of each division.
- 6. Prize Money vouchers will be provided to Chief Steward and will be presented to winners of each Division on conclusio9n of each class. It is the responsibility of the competitor to collect these Prize Money vouchers.
- 7. Prize Money paid on presenting the Prize Money Vouchers to Show Secretary Office prior to 2pm on Saturday 31 May 2025. (No Voucher=No Prize Money)
- 8. PRIZE MONEY VOUCHERS WILL NOT BE REISSUED.
- 9. Weather permitting- BRC has granted permission for horse vehicles only parking in the main arena. Southern End only. Entry will be via cattle gate. Horses may be tied in the spare empty Cattle shed near Cattle Washes. It is your responsibility to fully clean Main Arena and Cattle shed etc prior to leaving of all hay/manure/rubbish.
- 10.If wet weather Horse parking is to be in Horse Annex parking or Horse Stable area parking.
- 11. Main Arena must be left in clean, level-all divots leveled out/filled. No Manure/Hay.
- 12.If you wish for a Horse Stable complete Horse Stable booking form and forward the associated fee. Check rear of the Schedule for all Horse related forms.
- 13.Extreme Cowboy Racing will follow the set Extreme Cowboy Racing Rules for this event. Judge's decision is final.
- 14. All people/competitors will pay entry to Bundaberg Show as per Gate Admittance Fees.
