## WORKPLACE HEALTH AND SAFETY

All Queensland Chamber of Agriculture Societies Inc. affiliated Association Showgrounds are designated workplaces within the meaning of the Workplace Health and Safety Act 2011 and exhibitors/competitors are required to ensure that they and all persons under their direction or control, including their contractors or subcontractors, comply with all requirements of the Act. The Queensland Chamber of Agriculture Associations Inc hold each exhibitor responsible to discharge its obligations to provide and maintain a safe place and system of work during occupation by the exhibitor/competitor of any area of the affiliated Agricultural Associations Showgrounds/Precincts.

Each exhibitor/competitor will assess the risk to themselves, staff, volunteers, family, other exhibitors, Agricultural Society staff, show visitors, children and any person foreseeable affected by the presentation of their exhibit.

Exhibits will only be held and handled by competent persons whose experience is known to the Exhibitor/competitor. The exhibitors/competitors are advised that the use of Primus Stoves, any heating or lighting appliances of a like character, or any naked light, is strictly prohibited in Pavilions/stables/barns.

Any exhibitors/competitors intending to bring electrical equipment to the Showgrounds/Precinct will be required to ensure that such equipment is fitted with a residual current protection and that all electrical leads, tools and appliances have been inspected by a licensed electrical contractor and are currently tagged. The use of double adaptors is prohibited and all power boards must also be tested and tagged.

All exhibitors/competitors will comply with the requirements of the ACT and its Regulations and Standards in every respect. This is essential for the safety of all exhibitors/competitors and the general public. The ACT imposes very severe penalties in the event of noncompliance with its provisions. **JUNIOR BUTTER CAKE** - Iced on top only with vanilla icing

**BUTTER CAKE RECIPE**

115g butter, 2 eggs,  $\frac{3}{4}$  cup sugar,  $\frac{1}{2}$  cup of milk,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  cups of self raising flour

**Method**

Beat the butter and sugar until soft and creamy.

Beat the eggs and add a little at a time, beating well after each addition.

Add a little vanilla, then sifted flour and a pinch of salt alternately with milk, beginning and ending with flour. This is usually done with three additions of flour and two of milk.

Stir lightly until the mixture is soft dropping consistency. Spread in a loaf tin approx 21x15cm, greased with butter and cook in middle of the oven, heated to 180C for 35-40 minutes.

## Section 19 ICED WORKS

ALL FOOD EXHIBITS AT SHOW WILL BE DESTROYED ON CONCLUSION OF BUNDABERG SHOW. THIS IS AS PER COVIDSAFE PLAN RULES.

### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. There will be a limit of one entry per class per exhibitor.
2. No entry can be entered in more than one class.
3. All exhibits must be the bona fide work of the exhibitor.
4. Entries are to be iced and decorated on fruitcakes with the exception of the Sugar Craft Section.
5. Judges have the right to pierce cakes for foreign matters.
6. A points system will be used for judging.
7. Use of manufactured pillars (including wine glasses), tulle, ribbon, cachous, stamens (manufactured or handmade), floral tape, fine wire and a minimum amount of silver or gold paints are permitted.
8. Natural fine dried stems used with restraint and in conjunction with icing, to form part of sprays or floral arrangement is permissible, otherwise all iced work and decorations to be made using a sugar and edible medium.
9. Moulds and cutters may be used to assist in the making of icing decorations or accessories.
10. Use of dolls, toys or any glass, wooden, tin, plastic or any other manufactured materials are not permitted. No soft icings (cream, butter icings etc.) are allowed.
11. All baseboards to have small legs or runners for ease of handling and boards may be covered as a matter of choice. The entire entry must fit within the perimeter of the baseboard (no part of exhibit is allowed to protrude past board edge).
12. No restrictions have been made regarding size of exhibit boards, but we ask competitors to be realistic for ease of handling and exhibiting in showcases.
13. Once an entry is benched, cabinets must not be opened without permission of the Pavilion Manager or Chief Steward.
14. Failure to comply with these rules will result in disqualification.
15. Exhibitors who wish their entries to be sold can notify Stewards of the prices. The Bundaberg Regional Show Committee will charge a Commission of 10% for any exhibit sold during the Show.
