WORKPLACE HEALTH AND SAFETY

All Queensland Chamber of Agriculture Societies Inc. affiliated Association Showgrounds are designated workplaces within the meaning of the Workplace Health and Safety Act 2011 and exhibitors/competitors are required to ensure that they and all persons under their direction or control, including their contractors or subcontractors, comply with all requirements of the Act. The Queensland Chamber of Agriculture Associations Inc hold each exhibitor responsible to discharge its obligations to provide and maintain a safe place and system of work during occupation by the exhibitor/competitor of any area of the affiliated Agricultural Associations Showgrounds/Precincts.

Each exhibitor/competitor will assess the risk to themselves, staff, volunteers, family, other exhibitors, Agricultural Society staff, show visitors, children and any person foreseeably affected by the presentation of their exhibit.

Exhibits will only be held and handled by competent persons whose experience is known to the Exhibitor/competitor.

The exhibitors/competitors are advised that the use of Primus Stoves, any heating or lighting appliances of a like character, or any naked light, is strictly prohibited in Pavilions/stables/ barns.

Any exhibitors/competitors intending to bring electrical equipment to the Showgrounds/Precinct will be required to ensure that such equipment is fitted with a residual current protection and that all electrical leads, tools and appliances have been inspected by a licensed electrical contractor and are currently tagged. The use of double adaptors is prohibited and all power boards must also be tested and tagged.

All exhibitors/competitors will comply with the requirements of the ACT and its Regulations and Standards in every respect This is essential for the safety of all exhibitors/competitors and the general public. The ACT imposes very severe penalties in the event of noncompliance with its provisions. Any exhibitors/competitors who do not comply will not be allowed to exhibit at " Queensland and Chambe of Agriculture Association Inc. affiliated Shows".

SECTION 21 FINE ARTS

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

N.B. Within the context of these conditions, the words entry, exhibit, work, painting and drawing should be regarded as synonymous with each other

1. Exhibit must be the signed, **original** and unassisted work of the entrant and to have been completed since 1st June 2020: - i.e. Within the last twelve months
2. Framed works must not exceed 60cm X 40cm ie A3 size work plus mount & frame.
3. Unframed work on canvas is restricted to 60cm X 45cm (24" X 18")
4. A limit of two entries per person per class applies
5. All works to be fitted with "D" clips located 6cm from top of frame and braided cord ready for hanging, **otherwise the Society will not hang the work.**
6. Class 6 & 7 entries are restricted to A4 size and must be mounted on corflute or similar hard backing to facilitate pegging to stretched horizontal cord across the face of the display panels. Junior entries do not have to be framed.
7. The name, address, phone number and title must be clearly marked on the **back of the artwork.**
8. The Society reserves the right to not hang an exhibit if it is considered unsuitable for hanging and no discussion will be entered into.
9. If entries exceed available exhibition space; the steward reserves the right to select the final artwork to be exhibited. The Artists of any work set aside in those circumstances will be informed.
10. All reasonable care will be taken with works once they have been accepted by the Show Society, the Show Society will not accept any liability for loss or damage while in their care. Insurance is the responsibility of the Artist.
11. The Show Society reserves the right to have any entry reproduced for publicity in the press, on-line social media or on television, without liability for any form of remuneration to the exhibitor.
12. No responsibility will be accepted for artwork not collected.
13. All Exhibits **MUST** remain on display to the closing time of the Show.
14. **ENTRIES CLOSE:** Monday 17th May at 5.00 pm. **NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.**
15. Entries to be lodged at **THE SECRETARY'S OFFICE, SHOWGROUNDS, UNIVERSITY DRIVE, BUNDABERG.**
