

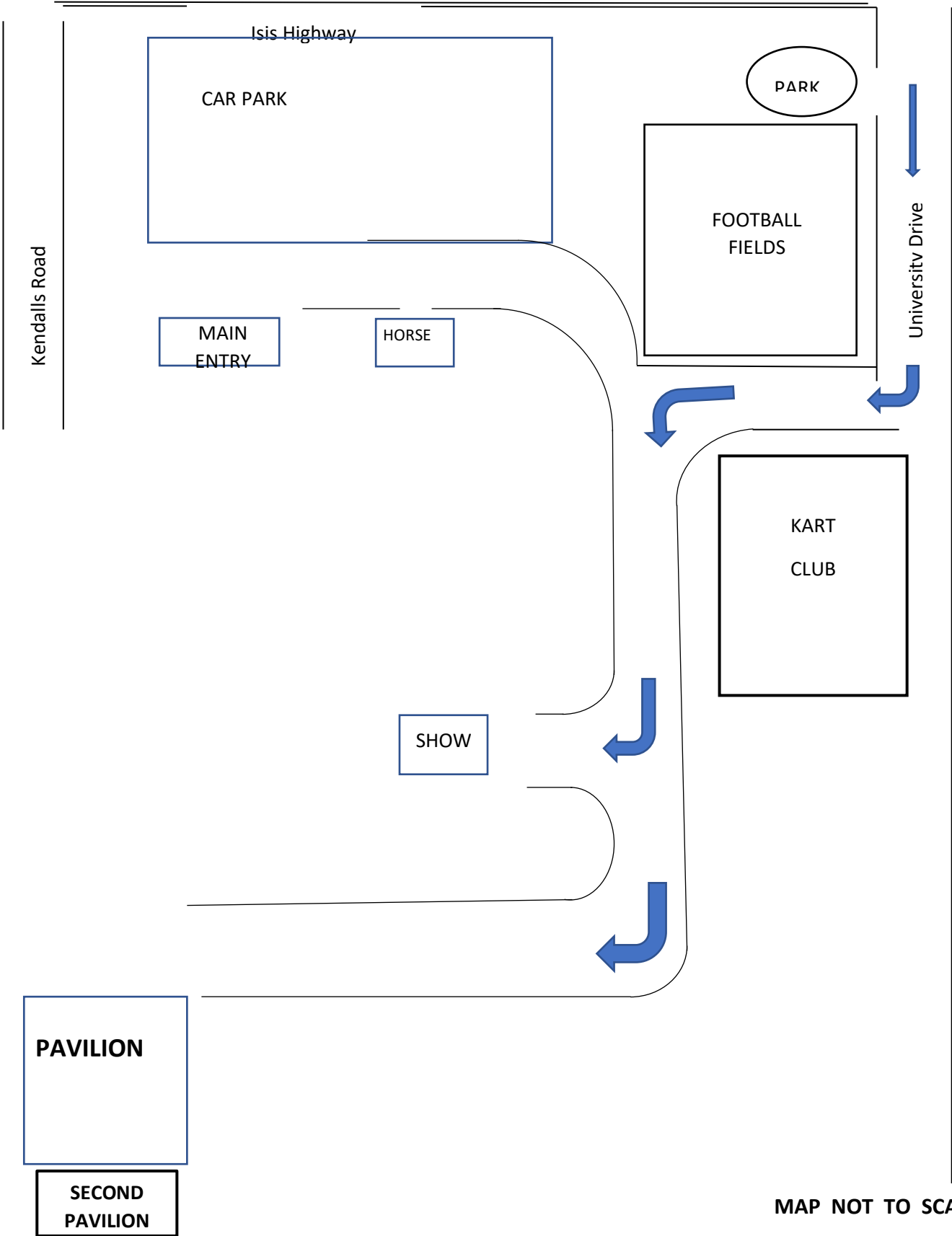

WORKPLACE HEALTH AND SAFETY

All Queensland Chamber of Agriculture Societies Inc. affiliated Association Showgrounds are designated workplaces within the meaning of the Workplace Health and Safety Act 2011 and exhibitors/competitors are required to ensure that they and all persons under their direction or control, including their contractors or subcontractors, comply with all requirements of the Act. The Queensland Chamber of Agriculture Associations Inc hold each exhibitor responsible to discharge Its obligations to provide and maintain a safe place and system of work during occupation by the exhibitor/competitor of any area of the affiliated Agricultural Associations Showgrounds/Precinct.

Each exhibitor/competitor will assess the risk to themselves, staff, volunteers, family, other exhibitors, Agricultural Society staff, show visitors, children and any person foreseeably affected by the presentation of their exhibit.

Exhibits will only be held and handled by competent persons whose experience Is known to the Exhibitor/ competitor.

The exhibitors/competitors are advised that the use of Primus Stoves, any heating or lighting appliances of a likecharacter, or any naked light, Is strictly prohibited in Pavilions/stables/barns.

Any exhibitors/competitors Intending to bring electrical equipment to the Showgrounds/Precinct will be required to ensure that such equipment Is fitted with a residual current protection and that all electrical lead s, tools and appliances have been Inspected by a licensed electrical contractor and are currently tagged. The use of double adaptors is prohibited, and all power boards must also be tested and tagged.

All exhibitors/competitors will comply with the requirements of the ACT end Its Regulations and Standards In every respect. This Is essential for the safety of all exhibitors/competitors and the general public. The ACT Imposes very severe penalties in the event of noncompliance with its provisions. Any exhibitors/competitors who do not comply will not be allowed to exhibit at "Queensland Chamber of Agriculture Association. affiliated Shows".

How to Enter this Section: Entry Forms, fully completed and signed, should be lodged at the Show Office by Friday 24th May by 4.00pm.

Entry: Fees: As per each class

No refunds if change of mind or unable to attend.

Where & when to bring exhibits: Exhibits are to be benched at the Main Pavilion between 5.00pm and 7.00pm on Tuesday 28th May 2024.

When to collect exhibits: Exhibits may be collected on Saturday 1st June 2024 between 8am and 10am unless otherwise arranged. Entries not collected by 10am will be forfeited.

Number of entries limit: There will be a limit of two (2) entries per class on all entries. Any entry may be entered in one class only.

Conditions - acceptance of exhibits: Any entry in this section may be cut at the discretion of the judge.

Presentation of exhibits: Plates will be provided for small quantities.

Standard of exhibits: The judges may withhold a prize if, in their opinion, any entry is not of sufficient quality to warrant same, especially in awarding Championships. No correspondence will be entered into.

Ownership of exhibits: All exhibits must be the bona fide produce of the exhibitors at the time of entry.

Exhibit reclassification: If in the chief Steward's opinion an exhibit is entered in a wrong class, such exhibit may be re-classed and judged accordingly.

Judging: The Judge's decision will be final, and no discussion or correspondence will be entered into it. Judging criteria are available from the Chief Steward upon request.

Acceptance of entries: The attention of intending exhibitors is drawn to the fact that entries are accepted subject to the rules of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies and to the Constitution and Rules of this Society, in addition to any special regulations which appear within this Schedule.
