

The use of double adaptors is prohibited, and all power boards must also be tested and tagged. All exhibitors/competitors will comply with the requirements of the ACT end Its Regulations and Standards In every respect. This Is essential for the safety of all exhibitors/competitors and the general public. The ACT Imposes very severe penalties in the event of noncompliance with its provisions. SECTION 19

SWEETS, BURNETT SUB CHAMBER EVENTS, PUDDING, SCONES, FRUIT CAKES, JUNIOR DIVISION.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

- There will be no limit of entries per class per exhibitor.
- No entry can be entered in more than one class.
- All exhibits must be the bona fide work of the exhibitor.
- ICED CAKES- Entries are to be iced and decorated on fruitcakes with exception of sugar craft classes. Use of manufactured pillars (including wine glasses) tulle, ribbon, cachous, stamens, (manufactured or handmade) floral tape, fine wire and minimum amount of silver or gold paints are permitted.
- Natural fine dried stems used with restraint and in conjunction with icing, to form part of sprays or floral arrangement is permissible, otherwise all iced work and decorations to be made using a sugar and edible medium.
- Judges have the right to pierce cakes for foreign matters.
- A points system will be used for judging.
- Moulds & cutters may be used to assist in the making of icing decorations or accessories.
- Use of dolls, toys or any glass, wooden, tin, plastic or any other manufactured materials are not permitted. No soft icing (cream butter icings etc.) is allowed.
- All baseboards have small legs or runners for ease of handling and boards may be covered as matter of choice. The entire entry must fit within the perimeter of the baseboard (no part of exhibit is allowed to protrude past board edge)
- No restrictions have been made regarding size of exhibit boards, but we ask competitors to be realistic for ease of handling and exhibiting in the showcases.
- Once an entry is benched, cabinets must not be opened without permission from the Pavilion Manager or Chief Steward.
- Failure to comply with these rules will result in disqualification.
- Exhibitors who wish their entries to be sold can notify the Stewards of the Prices. A small for sale sign may be placed on the article after judging with the owner's name and phone number.

19/5 RICH DARK FRUIT CAKE - Own recipe can be used: to be ½ pound (250gm) mixture with approx. 1.12kg of fruit to be used including currents, (whole) sultanas and raisins (cut), mixed peel, cherries and nuts optional. To be baked in a square tin not exceeding 20cm (8 inches).

19/6 ANZAC BUSCUITS – For ages 18 – 40 yrs - Recipe Makes 24: - 125gm butter, chopped, 1cup plain flour, ½ tsp bicarb soda, 1 cup rolled oats, 2tbs golden syrup, 2 tbs boiling water, ¾ cup desiccated coconut, 1 cup caster sugar. Method:- Combine butter and golden syrup in a pan, stir over heat until butter is melted. Stir in combined soda and water, then remaining ingredients. Mix well. Drop rounded teaspoons of mixture about 4cm apart on greased oven trays and flatten slightly. Bake in slow oven for about 20 minutes or until slightly brown. Cool on tray.

JUNIOR BUTTER CAKE – Iced on top only with Vanilla Icing.

Butter Cake Recipe:

115 g butter, 2 eggs, $\frac{3}{4}$ cup sugar, $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of milk, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ cups self-raising flour.

Method:

Beat butter and sugar until smooth and creamy. Beat the eggs and add a little at a time, beating well after each addition. Add a little vanilla, then sifted flour and a pinch of salt alternately with milk, beginning and ending with flour. This is usually done with three additions of flour and two of milk. Stir lightly until mixture is soft dropping consistency. Spread in a loaf tin approx. 21cm x 15 cm, greased with butter and cook in the middle of the oven, heated to 180C for 35-40 minutes.
