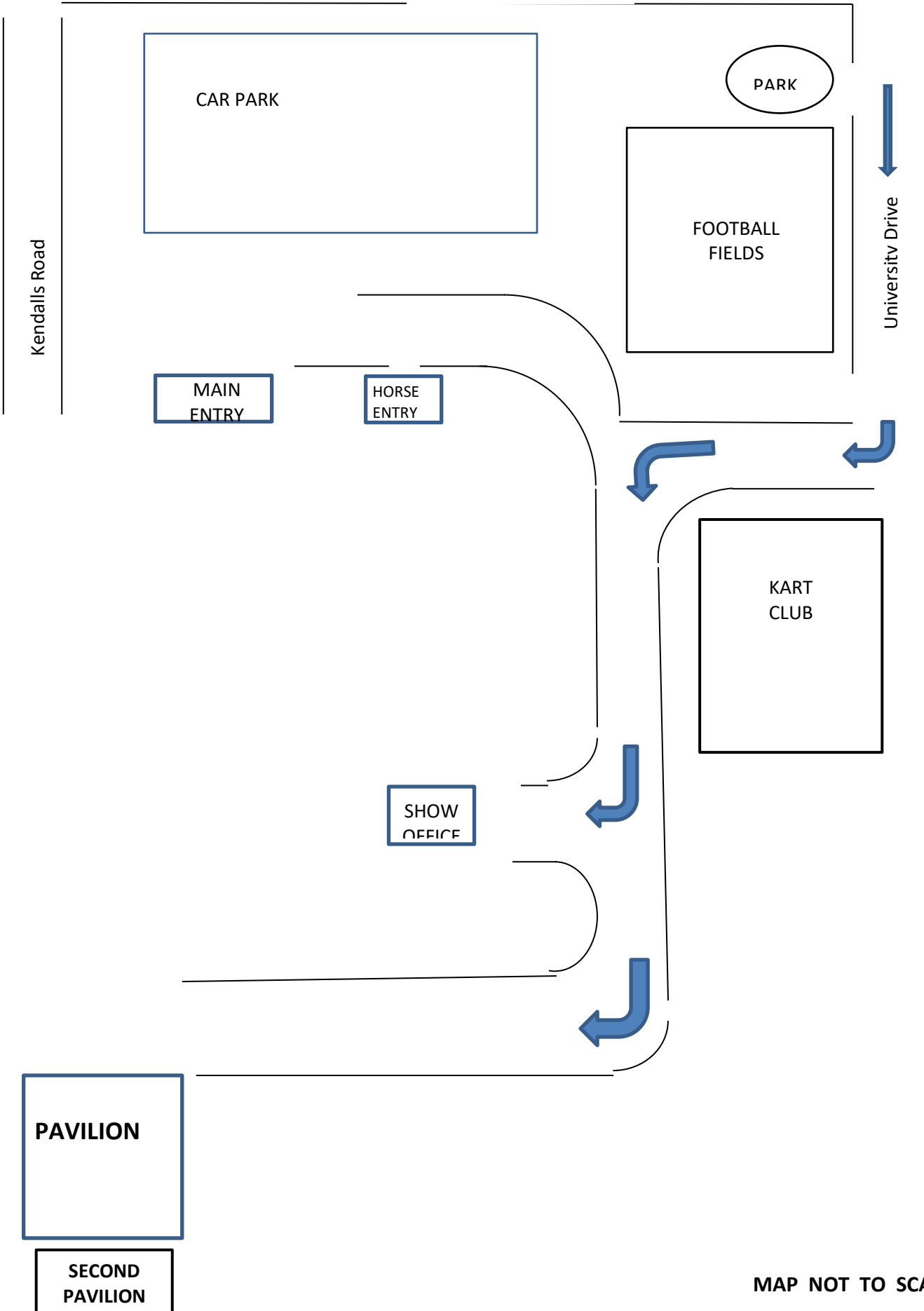

WORKPLACE HEALTH AND SAFETY

All Queensland Chamber of Agriculture Societies Inc. affiliated Association Showgrounds are designated workplaces within the meaning of the

Workplace Health and Safety Act 2011 and exhibitors/competitors are required to ensure that they and all persons under their direction or control, including their contractors or subcontractors, comply with all requirements of the Act. The Queensland Chamber of Agriculture Associations Inc hold each exhibitor responsible to discharge Its obligations to provide and maintain a safe place and system of work during occupation by the exhibitor/competitor of any area of the affiliated Agricultural Associations Showgrounds/Precinct.

Each exhibitor/competitor will assess the risk to themselves, staff, volunteers, family, other exhibitors, Agricultural Society staff, show visitors, children and any person foreseeably affected by the presentation of their exhibit.

Exhibits will only be held and handled by competent persons whose experience Is known to the Exhibitor/competitor.

The exhibitors/competitors are advised that the use of Primus Stoves, any heating or lighting appliances of a like character, or any naked light, Is strictly prohibited in Pavilions/stables/barns.

Any exhibitors/competitors Intending to bring electrical equipment to the Showgrounds/Precinct will be required to ensure that such equipment Is fitted with a residual current protection and that all electrical lead s, tools and appliances have been Inspected by a licensed electrical contractor and are currently tagged. The use of double adaptors is prohibited, and all power boards must also be tested and tagged.

All exhibitors/competitors will comply with the requirements of the ACT end Its Regulations and Standards In every respect. This Is essential for the safety of all exhibitors/competitors and the general public. The ACT Imposes very severe penalties in the event of noncompliance with its provisions. Any exhibitors/competitors who do not comply will not be allowed to exhibit at "Queensland Chamber of Agriculture Association. affiliated Shows".

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Classes, Except Classes 4 & 5, may be a COLOUR OR MONOCHROME PRINT –

MAXIMUM OF 5 PRINTS PER CLASS PER EXHIBITOR

Prints which have previously won a prize award at a Bundaberg Regional Show are not eligible for entry

CLASSES 1-7: SIZE LIMITS

PRINTS MUST BE SURFACE MOUNTED TO A STIFF BACKING CARD OR AFFIXED BEHIND A STIFF MATT CARD SURROUND THAT DOES NOT EXCEED THE OVERALL MAXIMUM OUTSIDE DIMENSIONS of 18inches X 18inches (45x45cm) for easy handling and display of your print during the show. (eg. a 12x14inch print on a 16x18inch backing mount card is acceptable.)

Class 1 SUBJECT- “PEOPLE” or “PORTRAIT”

Class 2 SUBJECT- “LANDSCAPE”, “SEASCAPE” or “CITYSCAPE”

Class 3 SUBJECT- “NATURE” (No domestic animals or plants.)

Class 4 COLOUR PRINT – “ANY SUBJECT”

Class 5 MONOCHROME PRINT – “ANY SUBJECT”

Class 6 SUBJECT- “CREATIVE IMAGERY or ALTERED REALITY”

All images used in the Class 6 must be photography taken by the Exhibitor.

Class 7 SUBJECT- “SPORT” or “ACTION”

CLASSES 8-9: SIZE LIMITS

PRINTS MUST BE SURFACE MOUNTED TO A STIFF BACKING CARD OR AFFIXED BEHIND A STIFF MATT CARD SURROUND THAT DOES NOT EXCEED THE OVERALL MAXIMUM OUTSIDE DIMENSIONS of 7inches X 7inches (18x18cm) for easy handling and display of your print during the show. . (eg. a 6x4inch print on a 5x7inch backing mount card is acceptable)

Class 8 SUBJECT – “PETS”

Class 9 FOR JUNIOR ENTRANTS – “ANY SUBJECT”

Class 9 Restricted to competitors aged 14yrs and under on first day of show.
Add ‘Date Of Birth’ to Entry Form.

***** HOW TO PREPARE YOUR PRINTS – ALL CLASSES *****

1. Exhibitors NAME, Phone number, and PRINT TITLE must be written on the back of the Print entry.
2. Prints must be delivered to the Pavilion with the Class Ticket attached to the back of the print. (See the “DELIVERY NOTES” above.)
3. Prints MUST BE PRINTED ON PHOTOGRAPHIC PAPER OR INKJET PHOTO PAPER, (no coloured paper printing allowed).
4. FRAMED PRINTS (including Glass) ARE NOT PERMITTED.
5. Prints must be prepared according to the requirements as per the classes you are entering:
See: Class Descriptions for further information and SIZE LIMITS.
6. Any print deemed unsuitably prepared as per the requirements, may not be exhibited.
7. Any print subject matter deemed unsuitable for public display, will not be judged or exhibited.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY – ALL EXHIBITORS

1. All entries must be on Photographic or Photo Inkjet paper , NO coloured paper printing allowed.
2. A print may be entered into one Class only.
3. The Exhibitor must have taken all images and have legal copyright ownership of the original Photographs for all Exhibits. NO STOCK or ‘plagiarized’ IMAGES ARE ALLOWED.
4. Maximum of 5 prints per Class per Exhibitor.
5. Any entry which has been awarded a Prize in any previous Bundaberg Regional Show will not be accepted.
6. The name of the exhibitor, including any watermarks or logo MUST NOT appear on the front of the print.
7. Your Entry MUST have the completed CLASS TICKET that has been issued by the Show Office, affixed to the BACK OF YOUR ENTRY.
8. At the discretion of the Chief Steward, prints deemed NOT MOUNTED AS PER THE CLASS REQUIREMENTS will not be judged or exhibited.
9. The Chief Stewards and Judges decisions are final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
10. No refund of entry fees for any reason.
