BUNDABERG REGIONAL SHOW THREE PERSON TEAM PENNING RULES

To be read in conjunction with Show Society Ground Rules

1. A Team consists of three (3) riders.
2. Juvenile, Open classes - A rider can compete in more than one team, but any nominated team can only compete once.
Wildcard class - A rider can only nominate once.
3. Teams are placed according to the highest number of cattle penned in the fastest time.
4. There are 30 head (or 21) of cattle used in the arena, with 10 (or 7) different coloured collars (3 head of cattle having the same colour).
Cattle herds will be changed following the ninth (or 6th) penning run unless the decision has been made with remaining team/s and committee that the competition be completed with the existing cattle.
5. The arena is divided into 2 sections. A line is drawn separating cattle and riders. This will be called the CATTLE line.
6. Time for a run commences when the first horse's nose crosses the cattle line.
7. The announcer will assign the colour of the collar when the first horse's nose crosses the cattle line.
8. The team must cut three or less head of their assigned coloured cattle and pen them within
 - a) 90 seconds for Open and Wildcard classes
 - b) 2 minutes for Juvenile classA warning bell/whistle will be given 30 secs prior to the finish time for the run.
9. To call for time, one team member's horse must break the plane of the pen gate by raising his/her hand above their head. Any team member may call time after one or more head of cattle have been penned. All unassigned cattle (strays) must be completely on the herd side of the cattle line when claiming time or the team will be judged a 'no time'. A rider whose horse enters the pen while calling for time will be disqualified.
10. A team can only call time once, and all riders must be on the pen side of the herd line.
11. The line of the gate will be determined by the judge on the day and be explained to the competitors before commencement of the competition.
12. No more than 5 head of cattle are allowed over the pen side of the cattle line. More than 5 head will result in disqualification.
13. When the claimed cattle are over the cattle line, all riders must immediately cross the line to pen their cattle. No riders can go back across the cattle line to the herd side, or the team will be disqualified.
14. No time will be given if incorrect cattle are in the pen when time is called.
15. At no stage are horse and rider permitted to enter the pen to remove any incorrect cattle (strays) or when claiming time. All horses must be under control when they reach the line of the gate.
16. No blocking of cattle in the pen by any team member is allowed while other cattle are still being sought. This will result in disqualification.
17. Once a team is in the arena any fall of horse and/or rider or lameness of horse will be up to the team to decide whether to continue or withdraw from their run.
18. A fallen rider must re-mount prior to attempting to block or hold cattle or the team will be disqualified.
19. Approved safety helmets must be worn by riders 18 years and under.
20. No whips allowed in the arena. Rings and tie-downs are not permitted.
21. A team using unnecessary rough handling or riding into the mob at excessive speed, excessive bumping, biting or forcing cattle to run into

the arena structure or each other will result in disqualification at the judge's discretion.

22. Unsportsmanlike conduct by a team or rider will result in disqualification. Unsportsmanlike conduct is defined as abuse of one's team members, horse or cattle and excessive use of foul language.
23. At the judge's discretion, a team may be awarded a re-run if one or more of their cattle are deemed unsuitable. The time of the re-run will be at the judge's discretion.
24. An elected committee of three people must be available to deal with any breaches of the rules or protests.
25. The organising committee may vary the rules to suit the event at the time. Any variations of these rules are to be advised prior to the commencement of the event.
26. In the event of a protest, the team protesting must submit in writing, with a fee of \$50, the reasons for their dispute. Should the protest be dismissed, no refund will be given. The committee's decision is final, and all appeals will remain confidential.
27. Teams will be called 3 times leading up to their designated run. If the team has not presented to the arena entry gate at the third call that run will be forfeited without refund.
28. Dress code in the arena – riders must wear a hat or riding helmet, long-sleeve shirt with a collar, suitable riding pants and riding footwear.
29. Stallions must be handled and ridden by a person 21 years or older and must not be left unattended on the grounds.
30. No riders will be allowed to compete unless a Horse Health Declaration is completed and signed.

THREE PERSON THREE HEAD TEAM PENNING RELAY (KNOCKOUT CHALLENGE) RULES

To be read in conjunction with Show Society Ground Rules

1. A Team consists of three (3) riders.
2. The arena is divided into 2 sections. A line is drawn separating cattle and riders. This will be called the CATTLE line.
3. Each section will have a pen.
4. Two teams compete against each other in arena at the same time and on entry are assigned the section of arena and pen they are to use by Announcer ie. Stable side or Bar side
5. There are 21 or 30 head of cattle used in the arena, with 7 or 10 different coloured collars or numbers (3 head of cattle having the same colour or number). Cattle herds will be changed following the 7th or 10th penning run unless the decision has been made with remaining team/s and committee that the competition be completed with the existing cattle.
6. The Judge will assign the colour or number of the collar to both teams when both teams' first competitor horse's noses are standing at the CATTLE line.
7. Both teams first competitor will receive a RELAY BATON and commence when the Announcer starts them.
8. **Each team member must individually cut one head** of their assigned colour or number cattle and bring it **across the CATTLE line to the PEN SIDE**, then **PASS BATON** to the **next team member on PEN SIDE** of CATTLE line.
9. Any team member can sort, block or hold cattle on pen side.
10. More than one team member on cattle side of line at any time will result in disqualification.
11. A dropped baton or baton being changed on cattle side of line will result in disqualification.
12. Cattle to be yarded in their assigned pen within **2 minutes**.
A warning bell/whistle will be given 30 secs prior to the finish time for the challenge.
13. To call for time, the team member's horse must break the plane of the pen gate by raising their RELAY BATON in his/her hand above their head. All unassigned cattle (strays) must be completely on the herd side of the cattle line when claiming time or the team will be judged a 'no time'. A rider whose horse enters the pen while calling

- for time will be disqualified.
14. A team can only call time once, and all riders must be on the pen side of the cattle line.
 15. The line of the gate will be determined by the judge on the day and be explained to the competitors before commencement of the competition.
 16. Both teams need to pen three head in the fastest time. The **slowest team is knocked out/eliminated** and the team with most head and fastest time remains in challenge, advancing to next round.
 17. If neither team pens one head in the time allocated, both teams are knocked out/eliminated.
 18. There will be byes allocated in draw where needed.
 19. No more than 5 head of cattle are allowed over the pen side of the cattle line. More than 5 head will result in disqualification.
 20. When the claimed cattle are over the cattle line, all riders must immediately cross the line to pen their cattle. No riders can go back across the cattle line to the herd side, or the team will be disqualified.
 21. No time will be given if incorrect cattle are in the pen when time is called.
 22. At no stage are horse and rider permitted to enter the pen to remove any incorrect cattle (strays) or when claiming time. All horses must be under control when they reach the line of the gate.
 23. No blocking of cattle in the pen by any team member is allowed while other cattle are still being sought. This will result in disqualification.
 24. Once a team is in the arena any fall of horse and/or rider or lameness of horse will be up to the team to decide whether to continue or withdraw from their run.
 25. A fallen rider must re-mount prior to attempting to block or hold cattle or the team will be disqualified.
 26. Approved safety helmets must be worn by riders 18 years and under.
 27. No whips allowed in the arena. Rings and tie-downs are not permitted.

28. A team using unnecessary rough handling or riding into the mob at excessive speed, excessive bumping, biting or forcing cattle to run into the arena structure or each other will result in disqualification at the judge's discretion.
29. At the judge's discretion, a team may be awarded a re-run if one or more of their cattle are deemed unsuitable. The re-run will happen straight away.
30. An elected committee of three people must be available to deal with any breaches of the rules or protests.

35. Stallions must be handled and ridden by a person 21 years or older and must not be left unattended on the grounds.
36. No riders will be allowed to compete unless a Horse Health Declaration is completed and signed.

BUNDABERG REGIONAL SHOW

TWO PERSON ONE HEAD TEAM PENNING (KNOCKOUT CHALLENGE) RULES

To be read in conjunction with Show Society Ground Rules

1. A Team consists of two (2) riders.
2. A rider may compete in two teams (maximum), but any nominated team can only compete once.
3. The arena is divided into 2 sections. A line is drawn separating cattle and riders. This will be called the CATTLE line.
4. Each section will have a pen.
5. Two teams compete against each other in arena at the same time and on entry are assigned the section of arena and pen they are to use by Announcer ie. Stable side or Bar side
6. There are 21 head of cattle used in the arena, with 7 different coloured collars or numbers (3 head of cattle having the same colour or number). Cattle herds will be changed following the 8th penning run unless the decision has been made with remaining team/s and committee that the competition be completed with the existing cattle.
7. The Judge will assign the colour or number of the collar to both teams when both teams' horse's noses are standing at the CATTLE line.
8. Both teams will commence when the Announcer starts them.
9. **Both teams** must cut **one head** of their assigned colour or number cattle and pen them in their assigned pen within **1 minute**.
A warning bell/whistle will be given 30 secs prior to the finish time for the challenge.
10. To call for time, one team member's horse must break the plane of the pen gate by raising his/her hand above their head. Any team member may call time after head of cattle have been penned. All unassigned cattle (strays) must be completely on the herd side of the cattle line when claiming time or the team will be judged a 'no time'. A rider whose horse enters the pen while calling for time will be disqualified.
11. A team can only call time once, and all riders must be on the pen side of the herd line.
12. The line of the gate will be determined by the judge on the day and be explained to the competitors before commencement of the competition.
13. Both teams need to pen one head in the fastest time. The **slowest team is knocked out/eliminated and the team with most head and fastest time remains in challenge, advancing to next round.**
 1. If neither team pens one head in the time allocated, both teams are knocked out/eliminated.
 2. There will be byes allocated in draw where needed.
 3. If the draw is such that the same rider is in both teams to Challenge each other. The teams will compete individually and are to be timed. The slowest team is knocked out/eliminated and the team with most head and fastest team remains in challenge, advancing to next round.
 4. No more than 3 head of cattle are allowed over the pen side of the cattle line. More than 3 head will result in disqualification.
5. When the claimed cattle are over the cattle line, all riders must immediately cross the line to pen their cattle. No riders can go back across the cattle line to the herd side, or the team will be disqualified.
6. No time will be given if incorrect cattle are in the pen when time is called.
7. At no stage are horse and rider permitted to enter the pen to remove any incorrect cattle (strays) or when claiming time. All horses must be under control when they reach the line of the gate.
8. No blocking of cattle in the pen by any team member is allowed while other cattle are still being sought. This will result in disqualification.
9. Once a team is in the arena any fall of horse and/or rider or lameness of horse will be up to the team to decide whether to continue or withdraw from their run.
10. A fallen rider must re-mount prior to attempting to block or hold cattle or the team will be disqualified.
11. Approved safety helmets must be worn by riders 18 years and under.
12. No whips allowed in the arena. Rings and tie-downs are not permitted.

BUNDABERG REGIONAL SHOW TWO PERSON TEAM PENNING RULES

To be read in conjunction with Show Society Ground Rules

1. A Team consists of two (2) riders.
2. A rider may compete in two teams (maximum), but any nominated team can only compete once.
3. Teams are placed according to the highest number of cattle penned in the fastest time.
4. There are 21 head of cattle used in the arena, with 7 different coloured collars (3 head of cattle having the same colour). Cattle herds will be changed following the 6th penning run unless the decision has been made with remaining team/s and committee that the competition be completed with the existing cattle.
5. The arena is divided into 2 sections. A line is drawn separating cattle and riders. This will be called the CATTLE line.
6. Time for a run commences when the first horse's nose crosses the cattle line.
7. The announcer will assign the colour of the collar when the first horse's nose crosses the cattle line.
8. The team must cut two or less head of their assigned coloured cattle and pen them within 60 seconds
A warning bell/whistle will be given 30 secs prior to the finish time for the run.
9. To call for time, one team member's horse must break the plane of the pen gate by raising his/her hand above their head. Any team member may call time after one or more head of cattle have been penned. All unassigned cattle (strays) must be completely on the herd side of the cattle line when claiming time or the team will be judged a 'no time'. A rider whose horse enters the pen while calling for time will be disqualified.
10. A team can only call time once, and all riders must be on the pen side of the herd line.
11. The line of the gate will be determined by the judge on the day and be explained to the competitors before commencement of the competition.
12. No more than 3 head of cattle are allowed over the pen side of the cattle line. More than 3 head will result in disqualification.
13. When the claimed cattle are over the cattle line, all riders must immediately cross the line to pen their cattle. No riders can go back across the cattle line to the herd side, or the team will be disqualified.
14. No time will be given if incorrect cattle are in the pen when time is called.
15. At no stage are horse and rider permitted to enter the pen to remove any incorrect cattle (strays) or when claiming time. All horses must be under control when they reach the line of the gate.
16. No blocking of cattle in the pen by any team member is allowed while other cattle are still being sought. This will result in disqualification.
17. Once a team is in the arena any fall of horse and/or rider or lameness of horse will be up to the team to decide whether to continue or withdraw from their run.
18. A fallen rider must re-mount prior to attempting to block or hold cattle or the team will be disqualified.
19. Approved safety helmets must be worn by riders 18 years and under.
20. No whips allowed in the arena. Rings and tie-downs are not permitted.

22. Unsportsmanlike conduct by a team or rider will result in disqualification. Unsportsmanlike conduct is defined as abuse of one's team members, horse or cattle and excessive use of foul language.
23. At the judge's discretion, a team may be awarded a re-run if one or more of their cattle are deemed unsuitable. The time of the re-run will be at the judge's discretion.
24. An elected committee of three people must be available to deal with any breaches of the rules or protests.
25. The organising committee may vary the rules to suit the event at the time. Any variations of these rules are to be advised prior to the commencement of the event.
26. In the event of a protest, the team protesting must submit in writing, with a fee of \$50, the reasons for their dispute. Should the protest be dismissed, no refund will be given. The committee's decision is final, and all appeals will remain confidential.
27. Teams will be called 3 times leading up to their designated run. If the team has not presented to the arena entry gate at the third call that run will be forfeited without refund.
28. Dress code in the arena – riders must wear a hat or riding helmet, long-sleeve shirt with a collar, suitable riding pants and riding footwear.
29. Stallions must be handled and ridden by a person 21 years or older and must not be left unattended on the grounds.
30. No riders will be allowed to compete unless a Horse Health Declaration is completed and signed.

BUNDABERG REGIONAL SHOW ARENA SORTING RULES

To be read in conjunction with Show Society Ground Rules

1. Teams (3 riders) attempt to sort cattle in numerical order from the mob through a gate to the other end of arena.
2. There will be 10 head of cattle numbered 0 to 9 with 1 spare to hold the mob.
3. Three (3) Riders will enter the Arena - the starting number will be announced when the nose of the first horse crosses the gateway.
4. The Judge will call a number between 0 and 9. IE: the Judge might call 6, this will be your first beast then you must follow on in upwards numerical order ... example of order would be 6,7,8,9,0,1,2,3,4,5.
5. You must put the cattle through the gate in that order. If a wrong number goes through the gate out of sequence - this will result in disqualification.
6. If the beast with no number gets through the gate, this will result in disqualification.
7. Time will be taken from when the last beast passes through the gate and all riders are on the sorted side of arena with the clean skin/s.
8. Horses must not break the line of the gate after the last beast has crossed, or it will be judged no time - or until judge requests cattle to be moved.
9. If no team gets all cattle through in the time allocated, places will be determined by number of cattle a team sorts in the time allocated.
10. If a team stops competing with less than 10 head sorted (e.g. at 5 head of cattle) and hold cattle already sorted until the clock runs out, the judge will call no time.
11. Riders have 2 minutes (Open class) or 2 minutes 30 seconds (Juvenile class) to complete their run
- a warning sound will be given with 30 seconds remaining of the run.
12. Running a beast into a fence or over the mob will result in disqualification, at the Judge's discretion.
13. No whips in the arena. No hitting of cattle with any object is allowed. Hazing cattle with hats, reins or rope will be cause for termination of that run.
14. At Judge's discretion, a team may be awarded a re-run if (1) or more of cattle is deemed unsuitable (health wise) or escapes the arena.
15. Competitors will only be called three (3) times to be present for their run. If that team is not present at the "in-gate area" by the third (3rd) call -that run may be made void at the Judge's discretion.
16. THE JUDGE'S DECISION WILL BE ABSOLUTELY FINAL.
17. Dress code in the arena – riders must wear a hat or riding helmet, long-sleeve shirt with a collar, suitable riding pants and riding footwear.
18. Approved safety helmets must be worn by riders 18 years and under.
19. In the event of a protest, the team protesting must submit in writing, with a fee of \$50, the reasons for their dispute. Should the protest be dismissed, no refund will be given. The committee's decision is final, and all appeals will remain confidential.
20. Herd changes to be every 6 or at Chief Stewards discretion - each mob must not run more than 4 times in one day.
