PRIVACY STATEMENT

Society Inc. to process exhibits and conduct competitions at the Bundaberg A P & I Society Inc show. By entering such event consent to your personal information being used for this purpose including this information being made available to sponsors, Associations, the media, the public, promotional purposes, archival purposes, published in publications or as it is otherwise required by Law.

All exhibitors have the right to access and alter personal information concerning themselves in the terms of the Privacy Act. This can be done by contacting the QCAS CEO or by writing to QCAS.

WORKPLACE HEALTH AND SAFETY

All Queensland Chamber of Agriculture Societies Inc. affiliated Association Showgrounds are designated workplaces within the meaning of the Workplace Health and Safety Act 2011 and exhibitors/competitors are required to ensure that they and all persons under their direction or control, including their contractors or subcontractors, comply with all requirements of the Act. The Queensland Chamber of Agriculture Associations Inc hold each exhibitor responsible to discharge its obligations to provide and maintain a safe place and system of work during occupation by the exhibitor/competitor of any area of the affiliated Agricultural Associations Showgrounds/Precincts.

Each exhibitor/competitor will assess the risk to themselves, staff, volunteers, family, other exhibitors, Agricultural Society staff, show visitors, children and any person foreseeably affected by the presentation of their exhibit.

Exhibits will only be held and handled by competent persons whose experience is known to the Exhibitor/competitor.

The exhibitors/competitors are advised that the use of Primus Stoves, any heating or lighting appliances of a like character, or any naked light, is strictly prohibited in Pavilions/stables/barns.

Any exhibitors/competitors intending to bring electrical equipment to the Showgrounds/Precinct will be required to ensure that such equipment is fitted with a residual current protection and that all electrical leads, tools and appliances have been inspected by a licensed electrical contractor and are currently tagged. The use of double adaptors is prohibited and all power boards must also be tested and tagged.

All exhibitors/competitors will comply with the requirements of the ACT and its Regulations and Standards in every respect. This is essential for the safety of all exhibitors/competitors and the general public. The ACT imposes very severe penalties in the event of noncompliance with its provisions. Any exhibitors/competitors who do not comply will not be allowed to exhibit at "Queensland Chamber of Agriculture Association Inc. affiliated Shows".

1. Exhibitors NAME, Phone number, and PRINT TITLE must be written on the back of the entry.
2. Prints must be submitted in a suitable folder or envelope, with your name CLEARLY MARKED on the OUTSIDE of the folder – No bags, ties, tape or staples! (This is so your prints can be easily repackaged and returned to you.)
3. Prints MUST BE PRINTED ON PHOTOGRAPHIC PAPER OR INKJET PHOTO PAPER, (no coloured paper printing allowed).
4. FRAMED PRINTS ARE NOT PERMITTED.
5. Prints must be prepared according to the requirements as per the classes you are entering: see Classes 1-6, and Classes 7-8 below, for further information.
6. Any print deemed unsuitably prepared as per the requirements, may not be exhibited.
7. Any print subject matter deemed unsuitable for public display, will not be judged or exhibited.

CLASSES 1-6: SIZE LIMITS

PRINTS, INCLUDING A MATT AND MOUNT BOARD, MUST BE SIZED WITHIN 18" X 18" (45x45cm) MAXIMUM OUTSIDE DIMENSIONS.

PRINTS MUST BE SURFACE MOUNTED TO CARD OR AFFIXED BEHIND A MATT CARD SURROUND THAT FITS WITHIN THE MAXIMUM SIZE LIMITS 18" X 18" (45x45cm) for easy handling and display of your print during the show.

CLASSES 7-8: SIZE LIMITS

PRINTS, INCLUDING A MATT OR MOUNT BOARD, MUST BE SIZED WITHIN 7" X 7" (18x18cm) MAXIMUM OUTSIDE DIMENSIONS. (eg. 5"x7" and Postcard 6"x4" are acceptable)

PRINTS MUST BE SURFACE MOUNTED TO CARD OR AFFIXED BEHIND A MATT CARD SURROUND THAT FITS WITHIN THE SIZE LIMITS 7" X 7" (18x18cm) for easy handling and display of your print during the show.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY – ALL EXHIBITORS

1. All entries must be on Photographic or Photo Inkjet paper , NO coloured paper printing allowed.
2. A print may be entered into one Class only.
3. The Exhibitor must have taken all images and have legal copyright ownership of the original Photographs for all Classes. NO STOCK IMAGES ARE ALLOWED.
4. Maximum of 5 prints per Class per Exhibitor.
5. Any entry which has been awarded a Prize in any previous Bundaberg Regional Show will not be accepted.
6. The name of the exhibitor, including any watermarks or logo MUST NOT appear on the front of the print.
7. Your Entry MUST have the completed CLASS TICKET that has been issued by the Show Office, affixed onto the BACK OF YOUR ENTRY.
8. At the discretion of the Chief Steward, prints deemed NOT MOUNTED AS PER THE CLASS REQUIREMENTS, will not be judged or exhibited.
9. The Chief Stewards and Judges decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
10. No refund of entry fees for any reason.
