PRIVACY STATEMENT

The information provided by Exhibitors is used by the Queensland Chamber of Agriculture Associations Inc. and the Bundaberg A.P. & I. Society Inc. to process exhibits and conduct competitions at the Bundaberg A P & I Society Inc show. By entering such event you consent to your personal information being used for this purpose including this information being made available to sponsors, breed Associations, the media, the public, promotional purposes, archival purposes, published in publications or as it is otherwise required by Law.

All exhibitors have the right to access and alter personal information concerning themselves in the terms of the Privacy Act. This can be done by contacting the QCAS CEO or by writing to QCAS.

WORKPLACE HEALTH AND SAFETY

All Queensland Chamber of Agriculture Societies Inc. affiliated Association Showgrounds are designated workplaces within the meaning of the Workplace Health and Safety Act 2011 and exhibitors/competitors are required to ensure that they and all persons under their direction or control, including their contractors or subcontractors, comply with all requirements of the Act. The Queensland Chamber of Agriculture Associations Inc hold each exhibitor responsible to discharge its obligations to provide and maintain a safe place and system of work during occupation by the exhibitor/competitor of any area of the affiliated Agricultural Associations Showgrounds/Precincts.

Each exhibitor/competitor will assess the risk to themselves, staff, volunteers, family, other exhibitors, Agricultural Society staff, show visitors, children and any person foreseeably affected by the presentation of their exhibit.

Exhibits will only be held and handled by competent persons whose experience is known to the Exhibitor/competitor.

The exhibitors/competitors are advised that the use of Primus Stoves, any heating or lighting appliances of a like character, or any naked light, is strictly prohibited in Pavilions/stables/barns.

Any exhibitors/competitors intending to bring electrical equipment to the Showgrounds/Precinct will be required to ensure that such equipment is fitted with a residual current protection and that all electrical leads, tools and appliances have been inspected by a licensed electrical contractor and are currently tagged. The use of double adaptors is prohibited and all power boards must also be tested and tagged.

All exhibitors/competitors will comply with the requirements of the ACT and its Regulations and Standards in every respect. This is essential for the safety of all exhibitors/competitors and the general public. The ACT imposes very severe penalties in the event of noncompliance with its provisions. Any exhibitors/competitors who do not comply will not be allowed to exhibit at "Queensland Chamber of Agriculture Association Inc. affiliated Shows".

Section 35 DOLLS & BEARS

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Entries may be entered in one class only.
2. Exhibit must **not** have won a prize at a previous Regional Show.
3. All entries to be made by entrant and completed within 18 months prior to start of Show.
4. Exhibits are being judged on workmanship and on the overall presentation.
- 4a Must state if dressing made by the exhibitor – otherwise will be deemed to have been dressed by another.
5. Exhibits which cannot be completely examined by the judges will be disqualified.
6. Final category decision must be specified by entrant and will not be changed once entered.
7. Decisions of the Judges will be final.
8. A sealed envelope containing the name, address and phone number of the exhibitor must be attached to underwear of dolls or to bears bottom by tacking or safety pin.
9. White cards must be attached to front of exhibit by tacking or safety pin.
10. Exhibits on stands must be on individual stands, no larger than the exhibit.
11. **ENTRIES CLOSE** - Friday, 22th May at 4.00 p.m.
12. **ENTRY FORMS TO BE DELIVERED TO THE SECRETARY, SHOWGROUNDS OFFICE, via UNIVERSITY DRIVE, BUNDABERG.**
13. Exhibits to be **delivered** to the Main Pavilion on **Sunday 23th May between 10.00am & 2.00pm**
14. Exhibits to be **collected** on **Saturday, 29th May between 9.30 a.m. and 10.30 a.m.**
